

In the management of public security, he has stood out for his ability to lead large-scale operations, coordinating with specialized units of other national and even international law enforcement agencies.







THE ARGENTINE FEDERAL POLICE IN THE INTERNATIONAL FIELD

The first contact with the Organization dates back to 1927. Since then, upon the approval of the National Executive Branch, the Institution has considered international police cooperation as a priority and an irreplaceable means to deal with the various challenges posed by organized crime; which today is increasing due to globalization.

Upon an Executive Order in 1962, the Argentine Federal Police (PFA) was confirmed as the only representative of the ICPO in the country. Today its National Central Bureau (NCB BUENOS AI-RES) is actively staffed by 300 police officers, including investigators, operators, preventers, who are committed to INTERPOL's seven Global Policing Goals. The permanent willingness of the PFA to work with INTERPOL is a constant expression of its commitment. A significant milestone is the Headquarters Agreement between the Argentine Republic and the Organization to establish the IN-TERPOL Regional Bureau for South America and the Command and Coordination Centre (CCC) in Buenos Aires.

PFA officers are seconded at the Regional Bureau in Buenos Aires, the CCC, the CCPI in Rio de Janeiro (Brazil) and two of them are also working at the General Secretariat in Lyon, France. The Institutional Strategic Plan aims to redouble efforts to increase the participation in other international organizations, have an active role in the United Nations Peacekeeping Missions and promote the position of Police Attachés in countries that we consider necessary due to the high flow of information exchange.

INTERPRETING NCB ISSUES:

To observe and analyze any issues in National Central Bureaus (NCBs), fully interpreting the realities of law enforcement agencies in the Americas to then bring them before the Executive Committee (EC).

LEGAL VALUE OF RED NOTICES:

To promote actions so that legal value is attributed to Red Notices in as many countries as possible, in order to facilitate the provisional arrest for extradition purposes.

TRAINING AND EXCHANGE:

To foster training projects and exchange of good practices at a regional level, recognizing the INTERPOL Virtual Academy as the highest expression of professional development.

4 PROACTIVITY:

To take decisive steps in the fight against organized crime with great determination and to observe the trends that call for the strategic intervention of INTERPOL.

FUNCTIONAL INTERACTION:

To facilitate a broader diffusion of the work of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files (CCF) and find common points with the operational activities of the NCBs.



6 OMNIPRESENCE:

To launch regional and international projects that enhance the efficiency of human, material and logistical resources, to help expand the reach of the organization.

7 FOLLOWING THE SUN:

To promote actions so the three Command and Coordination Centers (CCC) have equal capacities and responsiveness, so that urgent assistance outside Lyon's time remains the same.

8 ASSISTING THE FIRST LINES:

To promote the involvement of the National Central Bureaus in the design of the Organization's activities and priorities.

9 OVERCOMING ATTITUDE:

To understand that networks are no longer enough: ecosystems must be created for the information exchange among member countries through technologies applied to investigation, such as the INTERPOL Biometric Hub.

10 POLICING FORESIGHT:

To listen to the wise advice of our young police officers. Let's design the INTERPOL of tomorrow using future study techniques, on the basis of 100 years of history and today's challenging time.
