Design pieces in **ceramics**

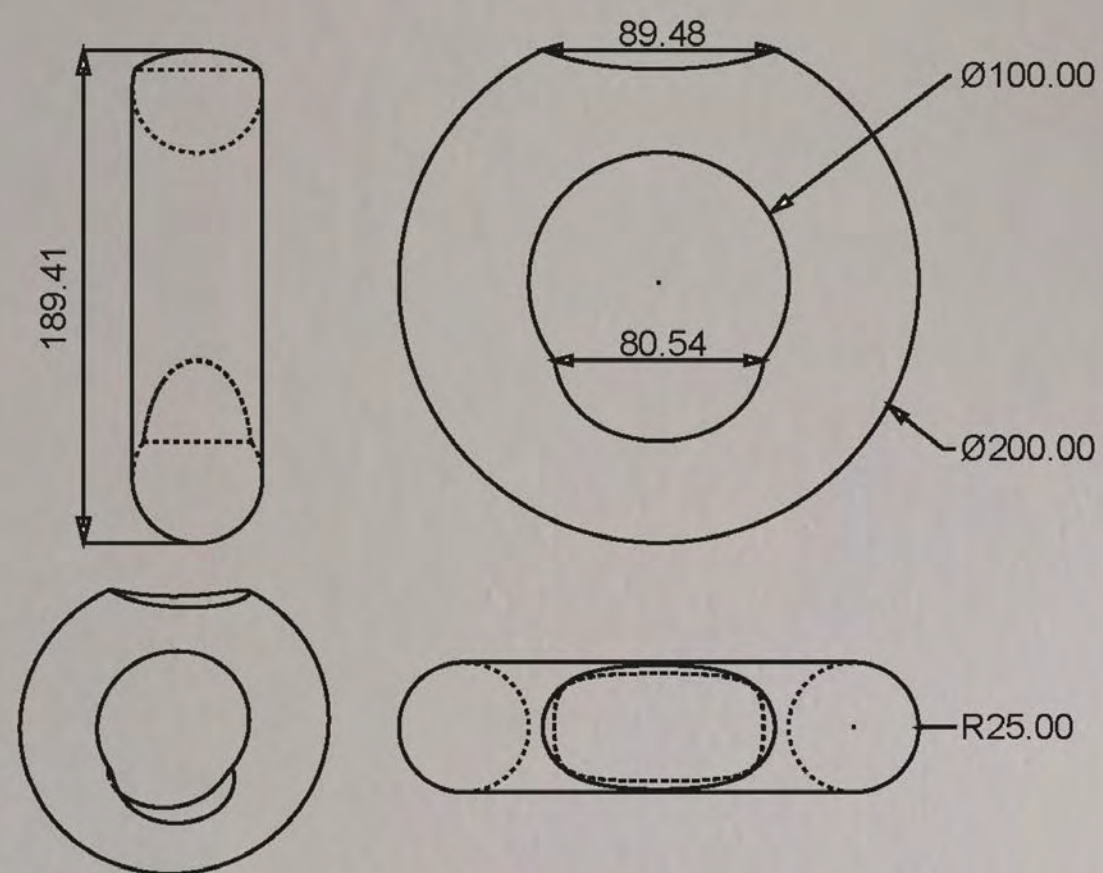


At **Mao Cerámica®**, with more than seven years of history, we create unique pieces that combine tradition and technology. Production is handcrafted, complemented with 3D modeling. We work with low-temperature clay and stoneware, achieving in each piece a balance between traditional techniques and innovation.

The development of this collection of planters arises from the need to incorporate green spaces in small environments. It is a set of compact, functional, and aesthetic pieces, designed to adapt to any corner of the home, both indoors and outdoors. They are especially suitable for low- maintenance plants that do not require frequent watering or direct sunlight.

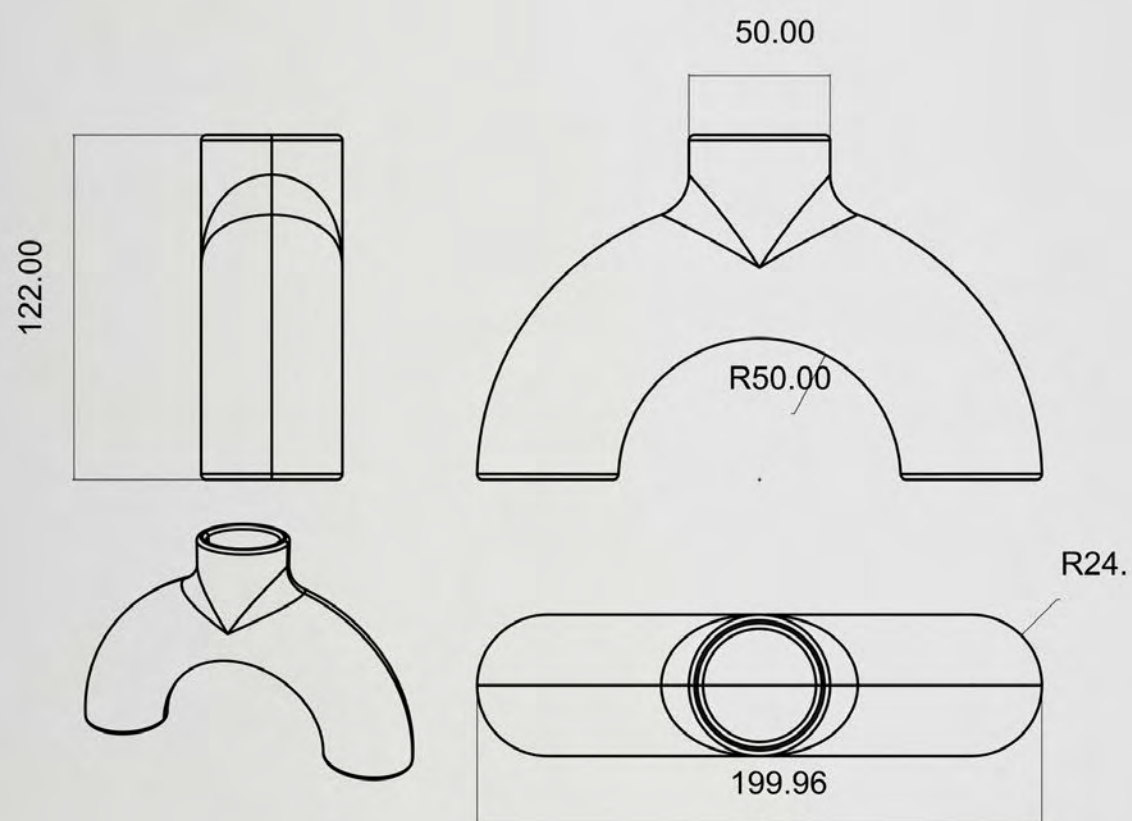
Hanging planter made of ceramic using potter's wheel techniques and glazed on the outside. It is designed so that even those with limited space can enjoy green corners inside their homes.

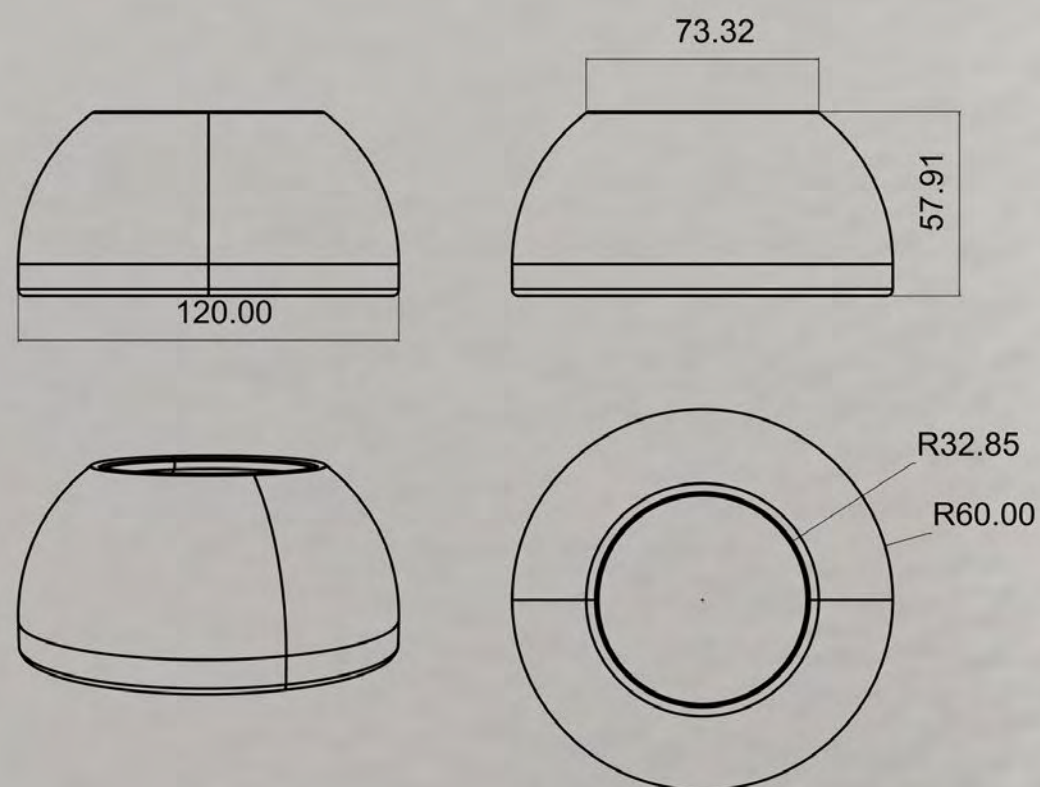

Semiesfera

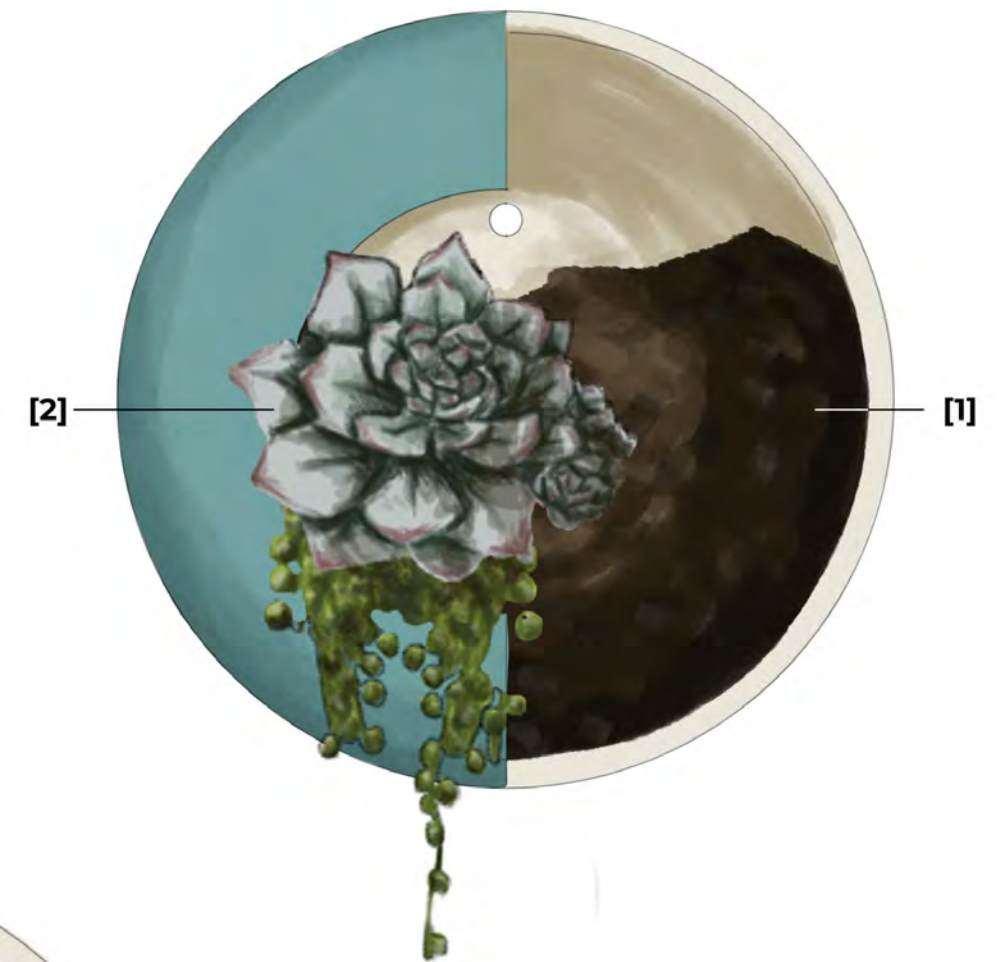
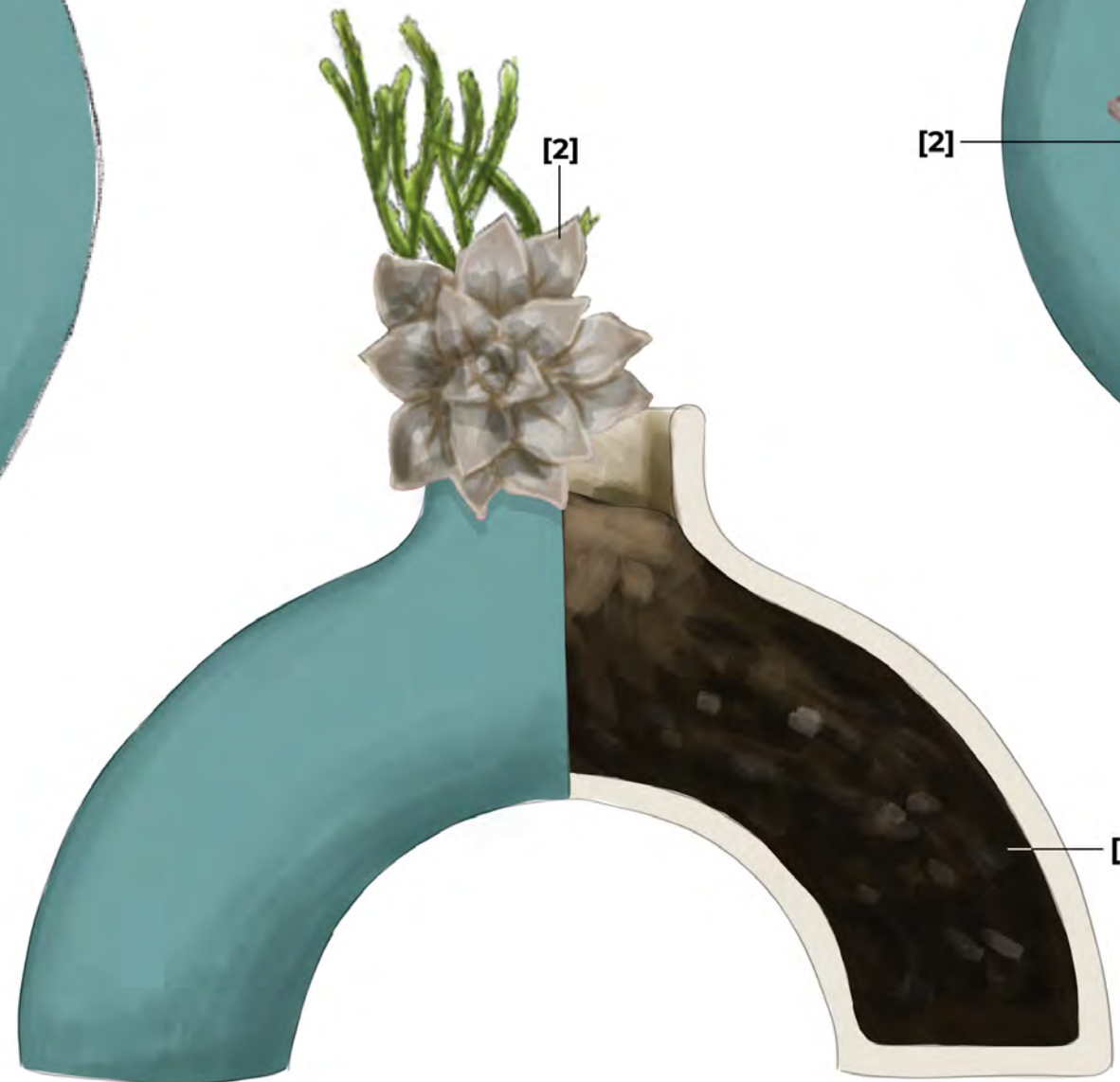

Versatile planter that can be used both hanging and standing. Shaped like a half-sphere, it is made of clay and finished with glaze. It is perfect for low-maintenance plants such as succulents, crassulas, and cacti.



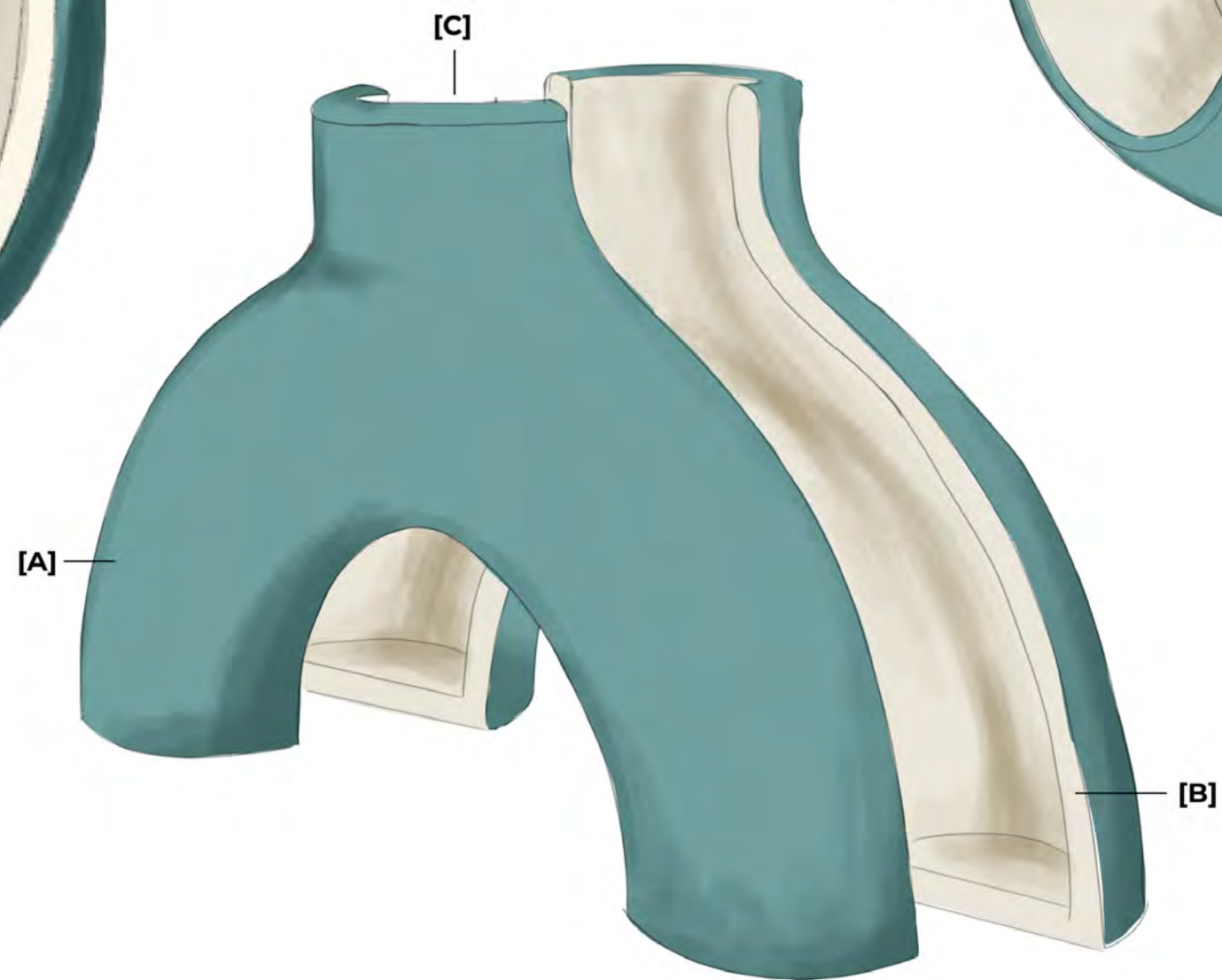
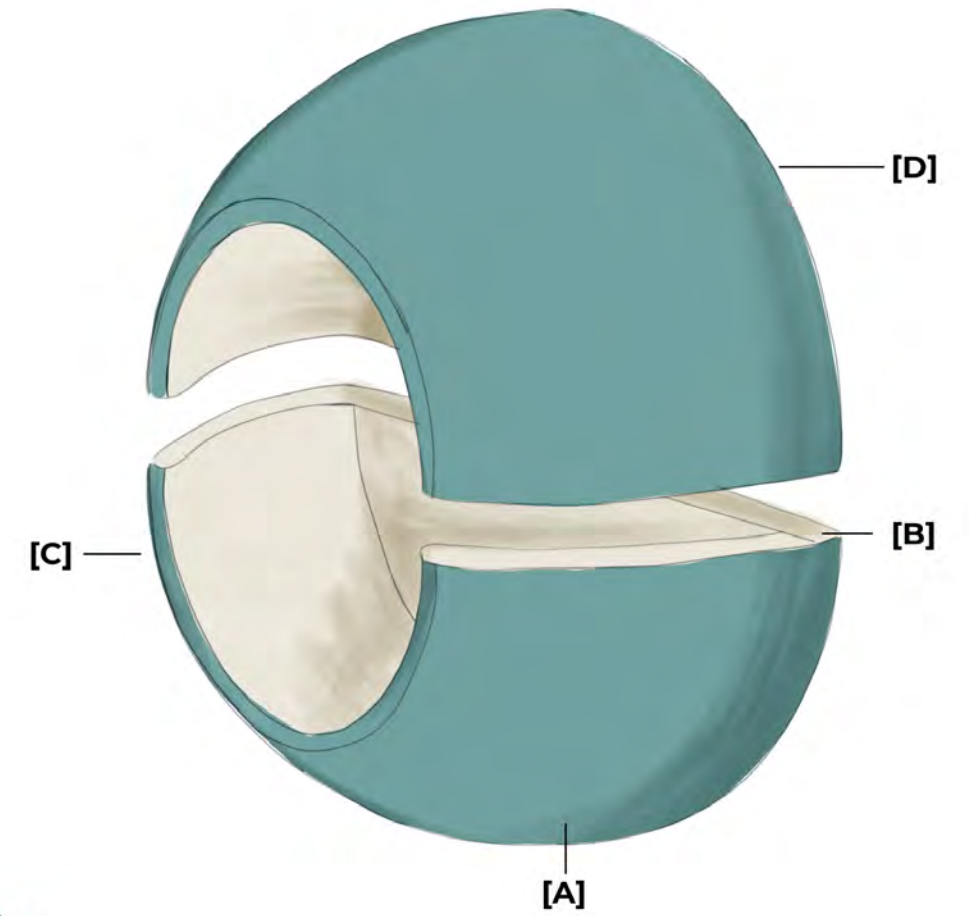
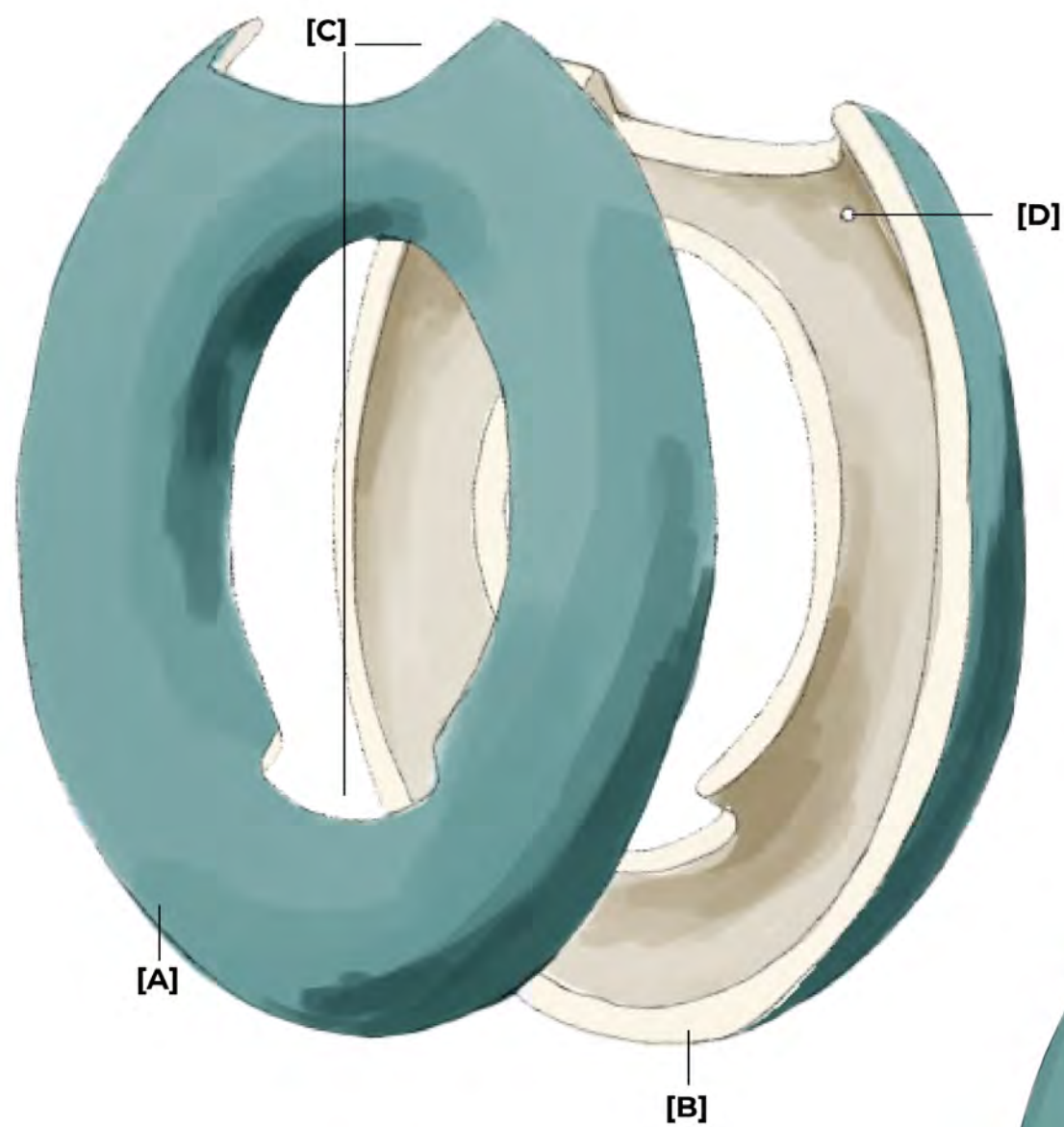

Opening on the back of the planter to facilitate wall mounting.

evoking the strength, texture, and movement of stone and water.*

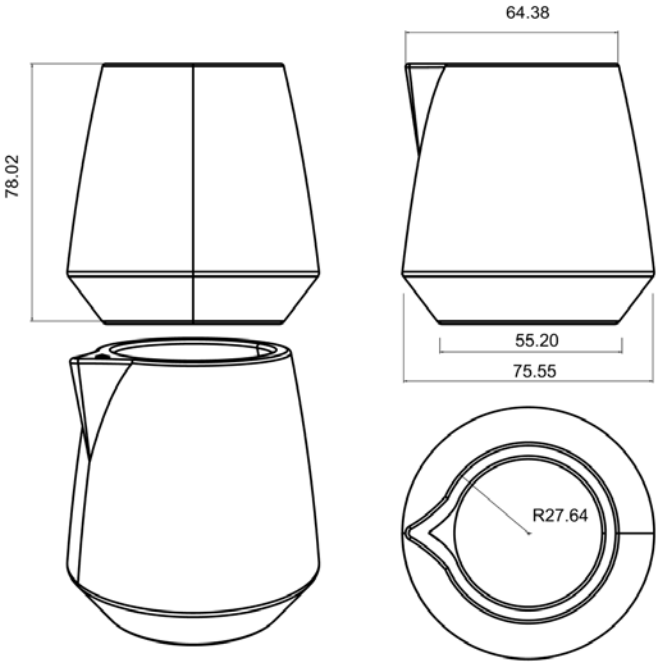




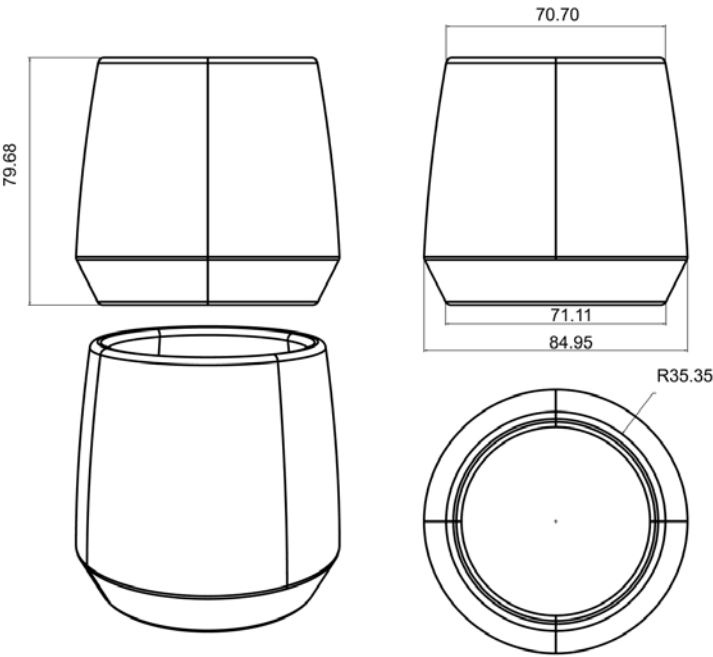
