Ries is a design studio based in Buenos Aires, Argentina focused on product and contemporary furniture design.

The studio's approach to design is influenced by its members' mixed background in architecture and industrial design, who combine different materials with production processes rooted in craft and industry to create pieces that seek to elevate the experience of the everyday life.

The studio was founded in 2016 and is directed by Marcos Altgelt and Tasio Picollo.

Work Philosophy



Material experimentation is at the heart of our practice. Being actively involved in the the making of our pieces allows us to have alternative readings of standardized production processes that embrace both success and failure as an outcome and therefore, our pieces are imprinted with these stories.



Drifting between aesthetic simplicity and technical complexity, our work covers diverse fields that range from the design of small objects to mid-scale furniture, as well as the creation of unique pieces to serial production.



Besides our in-house workshop, where we fabricate the vast majority of our steel pieces and do assembly, we work closely with a network of local suppliers and factories who manufacture our products as high quality as possible.

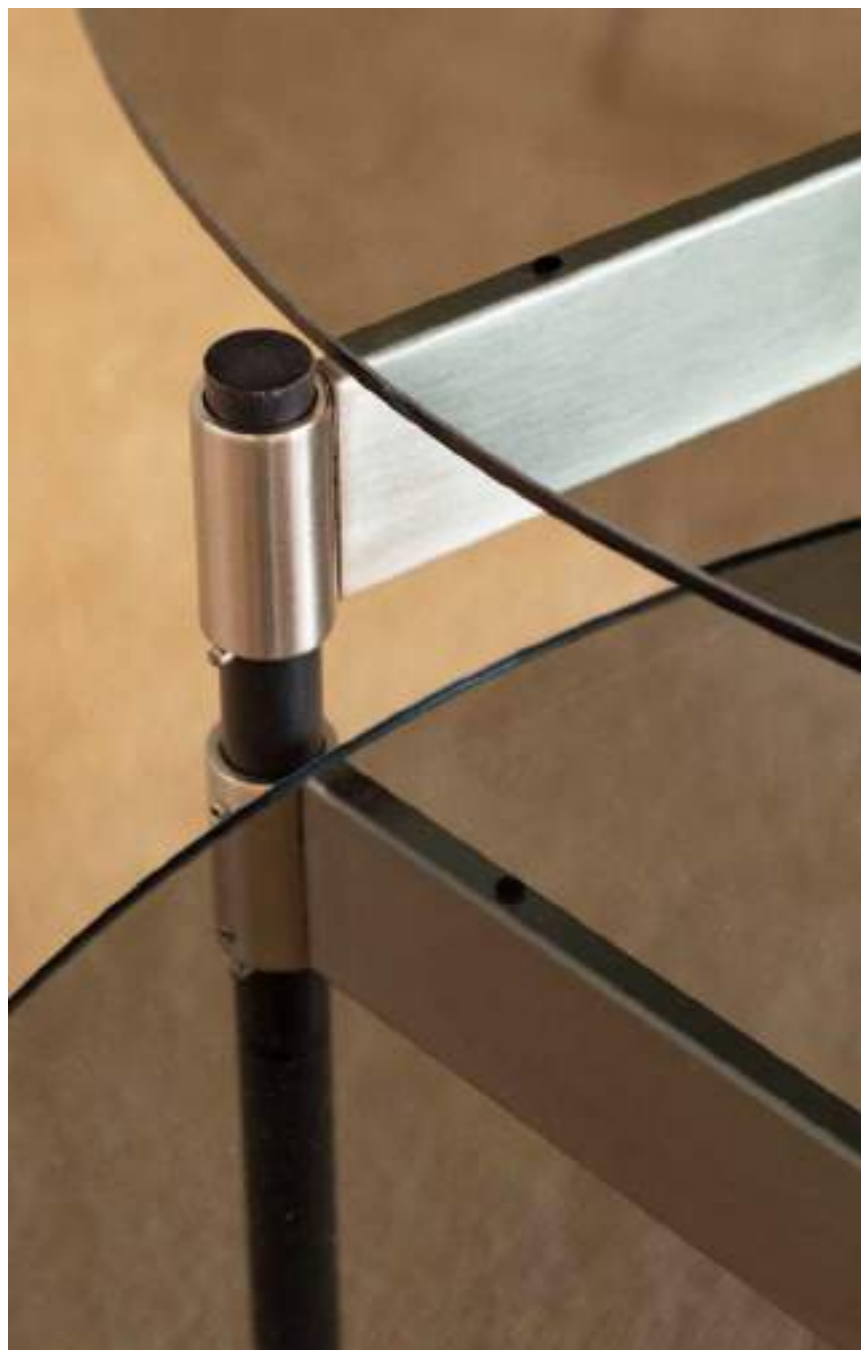

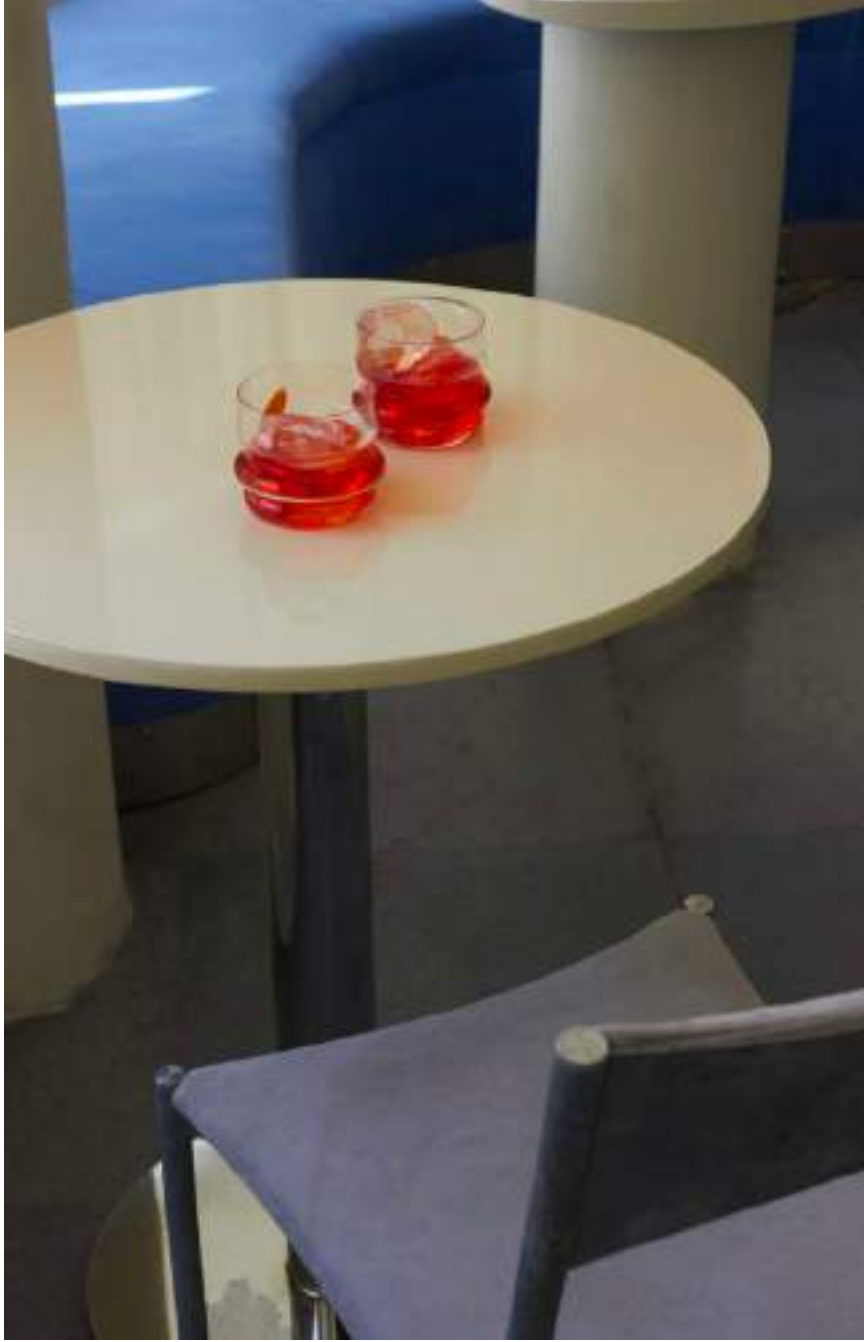

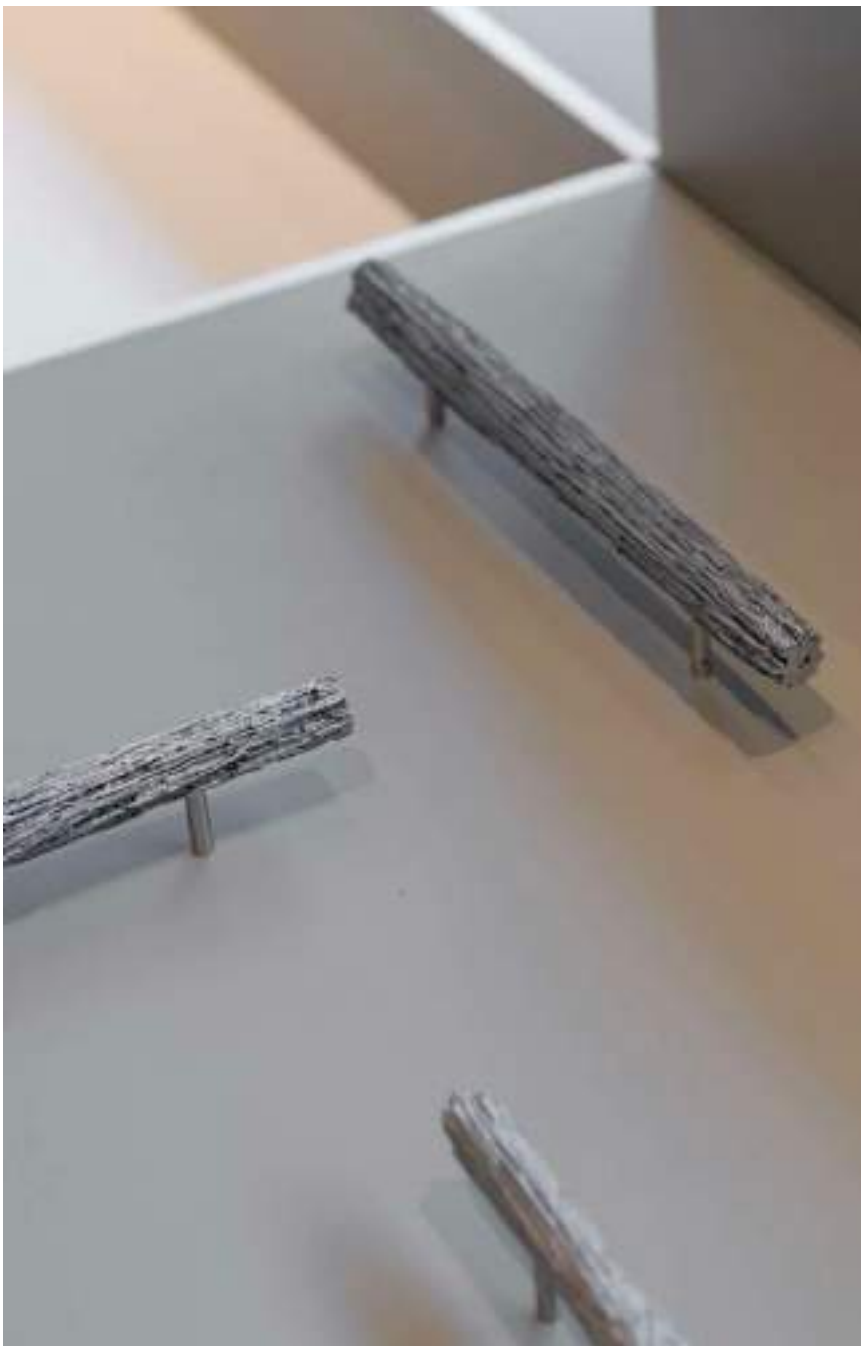
