Legacies and challenges in the construction of Latin American unity", an activity coordinated by the Argentine Foreign Ministry and the Latin American Council of Social Sciences (CLACSO).

For the Argentine Pro-Tempore Presidency, this commemoration represents one of the most significant events for the reflection and construction of a Latin American and Caribbean identity. For these reasons, the activities will be published by official networks, inviting them to join the network of regional universities to achieve maximum dissemination.

Conceptual framework

When San Martín addressed Simón Bolívar, he did so expressing to him that "America will not forget the day we embrace." Around this image, we will seek to emphasize the value of the historical encounter between American leaders





over the conjunctural differences; tracing a choral reflection around the vision of the struggles for the societies of an emancipated continent. What scope has that meeting had? Under what premises has it been interpreted? What controversies does he go through? How does it challenge us from our present?

This cycle of talks will seek to provide a diverse panorama from the social sciences, with a Latin American perspective on an event that still has connotations in our present.

Each of the blocks of talks will be previously filmed, and will be transmitted through links that will be informed in due course.
